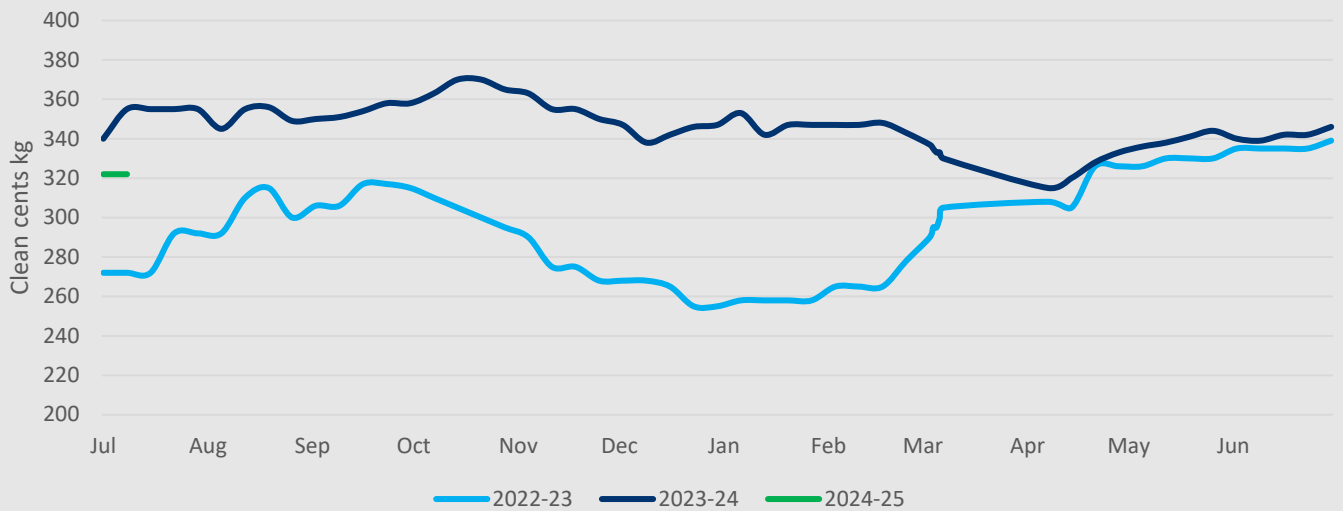

The first sale of the new season opened on a reasonably solid note for most Xbd styles reflecting a steady as she goes matching supply with demand. While there was some respite today, mid-micron wools continue to face head winds as reports of semi-processed similar wool types are not as fluid moving through the wool pipeline. A very small offering of new season merino wool met with strong competition exceeding levels fetched in Australia this week.
