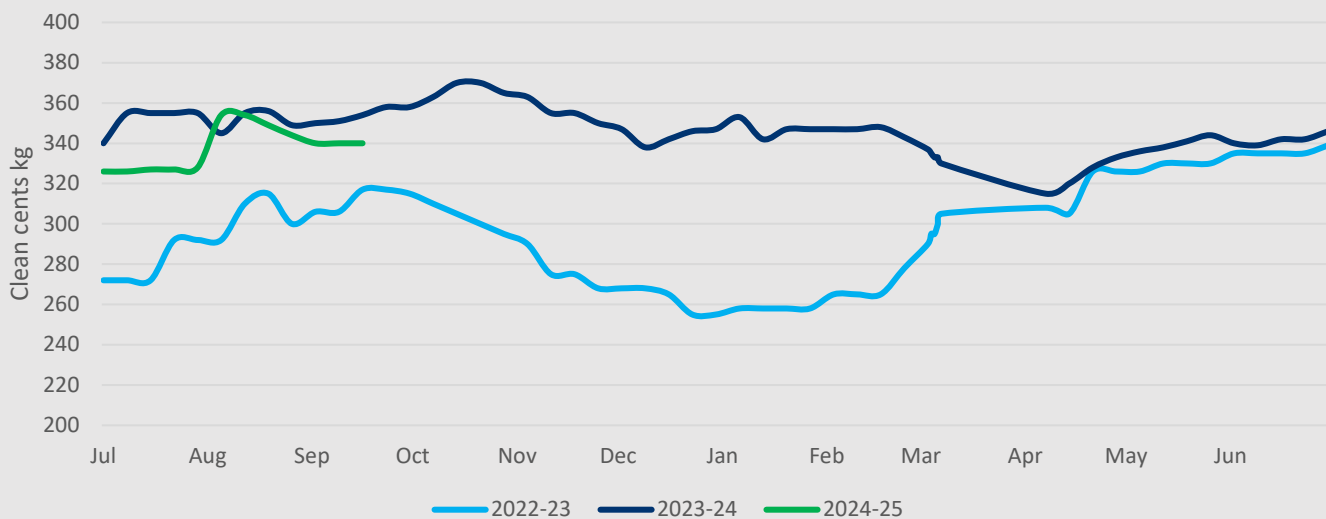

For the prominently fine wool sale, saw buyers having to increase their price limits to secure restricted fine wool volumes that have come forward for sale. Again, there was significant interest from a major Australian wool buying company. The mid-micron wools also enjoy positive pressure from the bench, especially the 27 and broader microns. The limited offering of Xbds saw slight downwards pressure and finished largely in buyers' favour.
